The **SEDOS Mission Symposium**, held from **11 to 15 October 2021**, was a great success, more than 800 registered, and 250 to 350 people joined online. The talks given at the Symposium will be published by **ORBIS BOOKS** under the title **“New Trends in Mission, the Emerging Future”**. The book will be ready by June of this year. We will inform you when the book comes out. The **SEDOS Annual General Assembly 2021** was well attended, online as well as in person. Directly after the General Assembly we had a joyful **Christmas Party** at Casa Lasalle.

The programs for the **two upcoming seminars** are as good as ready.

First, the **SEDOS Spring Session**, will be held **on Friday, 11th of March 2022**, with the theme **Mission in a Secular Europe**. It will be a webinar, thus online from Rome. One of the speakers will be Fr. Timothy Radcliffe, OP. Second, the **SEDOS Residential Seminar will take place from Monday, 9 May till Friday, 13 May 2022, in Ariccia**. The theme chosen is **Formation for Mission**.
